Dear Parents, Seniors, Post High School Graduate Applicants:

The Klue Scholarship is available to any graduate of LLCS who is pursuing some form of post-secondary education or career training. Post-secondary education or career training must be full time (12 credit hours or by their program's definition). Scholarships are awarded based on academic performance and the strength, quality, integrity, and professionalism of their essay.

The academic performance for a post high-school graduate will be based upon the applicant's grade point average from the most recent semester attended prior to submitting the application. **Official** transcripts must be mailed to LLCS as proof of the applicant's most recent semester GPA. The academic performance for a high school senior will be based on their overall high school grade point average. High school seniors who are a member in good standing of the National Honor Society will receive a bonus (\$200).

All applicants are asked to complete an essay providing information regarding your current extracurricular and community service activities, and any recent awards or recognition you have received. The essay must also include information regarding your personal strengths and weaknesses and reasons why you believe you deserve a Klue scholarship. The essay must be a minimum of 300 words.

Award amounts vary every year depending on the amount available in the scholarship fund and the number of applicants. **Applications, including essay and official transcript, must be received at LLCS by 4 pm on Monday, May 1, 2017.** The scholarship must be applied for annually. Late or incomplete applications will not be considered by the committee. It is your responsibility to confirm with the guidance office that your application is complete by the deadline. A scholarship application may be obtained by contacting the school.

Once the scholarship committee meets and your award has been determined, you will receive a letter from the Business Office. When you attend your program in the fall, you must send official enrollment verification to Long Lake Central School, Attn: Business Manager, PO Box 217, Long Lake, NY 12847 by May 1, 2018. The enrollment verification letter from your college or training program must indicate full-time status.
